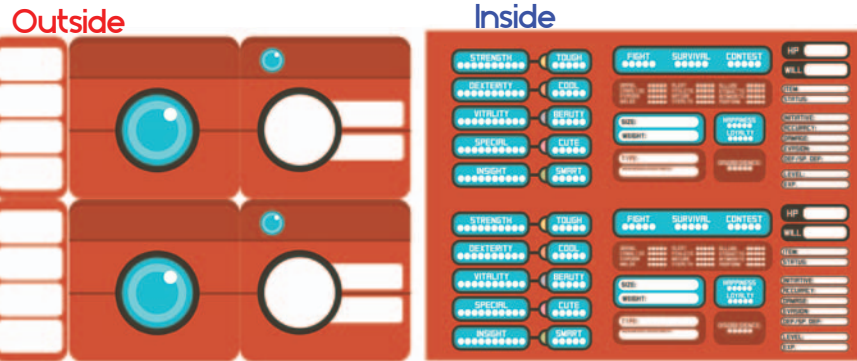


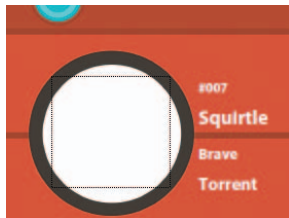
# Instructions – Pokémon Character Sheet

First of all, you'll need the program Acrobat Reader 11 or superior to be able to edit the file. You can easily find it on the internet and it's free to download.

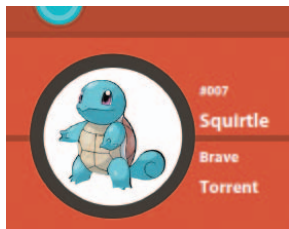
Once you are able to open and edit the file, you'll notice the Character sheet has two parts.



You'll need to fill the information by typing in the boxes and clicking on the circles.



For your Pokémon Picture, click on the blank space and choose your file. It must be a picture with no background in .pdf format. (You can change the format of a regular picture file by right clicking on it)



There you go!

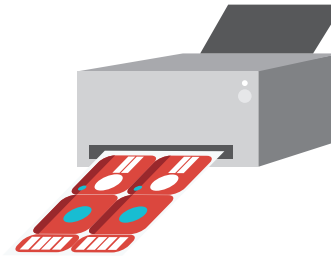
You may also leave it blank to draw a picture or use a sticker!



You can click under the attribute circles to remember the attribute limit of your Pokémon.

Once everything is ready it's time to print!

Print the Outside part first



Reverse it to print the Inside on the other side of the sheet.

If you need help, ask an adult or use a print service.



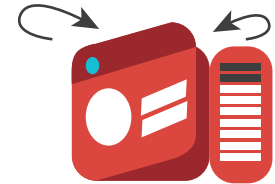
Once it's printed on both sides, Cut one of the character sheets.
